



What is a CCBHC?

A Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) is an approved established clinic that exhibits the quality and access to comprehensive services outlined in the CCBHC model. The goal of these centers is to improve the quality of services related to mental health and substance use disorder treatment and expand access to these services within the community. This includes access to addiction treatment, crisis services, and outpatient care for adults and children with complex needs. Veterans and active-duty military clients will find access to support and care uniquely tailored to their treatment needs.

Qualifying Individuals

Clara Martin Center's goal through our CCBHC services is to expand quality healthcare to anyone who needs it, regardless of their insurance. We don't let financial hardship or lack of insurance stand in the way of individuals receiving the care they need. Sliding fee scale available for individuals who are uninsured, as well as a fee waiver program to eligible individuals.
